### MINUTES OF THE CHEROKEE PRESBYTERY STATED MEETING MARCH 16, 2023, 2PM First Presbyterian Church, Cartersville

### Call to Order/Land Acknowledgement/Quorum

The meeting was called to order by Ruling Elder Bill Byars, Moderator, at 2:00 p.m. The Moderator offered a land acknowledgement, and opened the meeting with prayer. The Moderator then declared a quorum was present.

# Seating of Corresponding Members

The Stated Clerk reported that Jihyun Oh, a minister member of the Presbytery of Greater Atlanta was present, and asked that she be seated as a corresponding member. There were no objections, and this was so ordered by the Moderator.

#### Welcome / First Time Commissioners / Procedures

The Moderator reported that Rev. Leigh Jones, pastor of First Presbyterian Church, Cartersville, was not able to be present at the meeting, The Moderator stated that Cherokee Presbytery was grateful to First Cartersville for hosting the Presbytery meeting. First time commissioners were recognized and welcomed - Elder Kathy Perdue, Heritage, and Terry Sharon, Faith. The Moderator reviewed procedures for the meeting.

# Consent Agenda / Approval of Agenda

The Moderator stated that a consent agenda would be utilized for the proposed Amendments to the *Book of Order*. In approving the consent agenda, the Presbytery would be approving the items on that agenda. The Moderator reported that Amendments 22-E, 22-CC, 22-DD, 22-EE, 22-FF, and 22-GG had been pulled from the consent agenda.

The Moderator asked if anyone wished to pull any additional amendments from the consent agenda; no additional amendments were removed from the consent agenda. The consent agenda, as presented, was approved by voice vote.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the agenda was approved as presented without objection.

#### Committee on Representation Report

Elder Erma Jones, chair of the Committee on Representation, presented the committee's report. The Committee on Representation recommended the following persons be elected to serve as indicated:

Dr. Ken McKenzie (HR), Permanent Judicial Commission, Class of 2028 Marlene Michalke (Macland), Committee on Representation, Class of 2024 Dr. Reginaldo Braga (ITC Seminary), Commission on Ministry, Class of 2024 The Moderator opened the floor for additional nominations, and there were none. The slate, as presented, was approved.

Mrs. Jones reminded commissioners that there were many needs, and encouraged people to be in touch with the Committee on Representation if they wished to serve on a Presbytery committee.

The Moderator took a point of personal privilege and recognized Mr. Lavert Jones, who was present at the meeting. Commissioners applauded Mr. Jones.

#### Proposed Amendments to the *Book of Order*

Therese Howell, Stated Clerk, presented information related to the proposed amendments to the *Book of Order*. Of the 33 proposed amendments, the Presbytery approved 27 on the consent agenda. The Presbytery's commissioners to the 225<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, Rev. Paulo Mendez and Ruling Elder Nancy Tatnall, and Young Adult Advisory Delegate, Sidney Gunter, were present and could answer questions about the amendments.
