Congregational Health Team Report RE LaVert Jones

Over the past several months CHT has been in discernment seeking the path for us to follow in ministering to Cherokee Presbytery. CHT has been engaged in research and investigating options that would maximize the utilization of our resources.

To get started, we are considering a two-prong approach: (1) provide a workshop for Congregational Health and other interested ministry leaders and (2) a workshop for churches to inspire, educate and offer a transforming vision to their chosen representative leaders. Our aim is to build a strong presbytery leadership group.

The first workshop for ministry teams, scheduled for February 2018, will provide us with concepts, language, skills that can help us better serve in our respective positions and also serve to help us better relate to churches and pastors in facing the challenge and opportunities that lie before them.

We continue our efforts to make personal contact with each church, and hopefully build a growing understanding of each church's character, gifts, celebrations, issues, conflicts and vision. Those personal connections are invaluable for us to provide more effective and personal support. Part of our outreach is to visit congregations to help build a more solid relationship. We have already visited a session meeting which has been beneficial. For our July meeting, we were graciously hosted by Light of Hope PC and received a very impressive overview of their journey.

We continue to clarify, shape, and seek to articulate what CHT is and does, as we grow into the presbytery restructure process. We will, as individuals, commit to continue our own work of

spiritual growth and personal pursuit of knowledge relative to leadership and enabling congregational health.

- Dismiss Teaching Elders to other presbyteries.
- Establish and dissolve pastoral positions when requested by sessions (G-2.0504a).
- Approve and review temporary pastoral relationships, including Interims (G-2.0504b).
- Grant requests from Teaching Elders for release from exercise of ordered ministry (G-2.0507) with the reasons for such release recorded in the minutes of the Presbytery.
- Commission, review, and renew commissions of Ruling Elders (G-2.1001).

- Perform the initial in-depth examination of Teaching Elders seeking membership in the Presbytery (G-3.0306). By practice, include members of Congregational Health Team in examinations.
- Grant status of Honorable Retirement to Teaching Elders (G-2.0203c).
- Approve calls of Teaching Elders moving within the Presbytery. Approve moderators of sessions for churches without an installed pastor (G-1.0504).
- Designate persons to moderate session and congregational meetings when requested to do so by moderator of record (G-3.0104)
- Initiate/concur in the request for an Administrative Commission
- Maintain Pulpit Supply list.
- Develop/maintain policy for minimum terms of call and sabbaticals

- 3. To explore and implement efforts by the ministry units and churches of Cherokee Presbytery (perhaps the Coordinating Team in concert with the Congregational Health, Building Leadership, & Mission Teams, etc.) which help to support and sustain EGPC as an approved & official immigrant NCD,

including such factors as:

- A. Visiting and participating in EGPC worship services and special activities to see firsthand the mission and ministries of the congregation;
- B. Helping to secure grants and/or other special supportive funding, especially as related to the call of a pastor;
- C. Providing leadership development and training in particularly helpful areas, such as interpretation of PC(USA) constitutional, confessional, and polity matters.

Stated Clerk and Mission Coordinator Position Description

Stated Clerk:

The duties of the Stated Clerk shall be:

- a) To serve as the official channel of communication within and on behalf of the Presbytery both to and from all councils/agencies of the church. (e.g. Synod)
- b) Maintain minutes/documentation and bylaws for presbytery Provide oversight as minutes are done volunteer Assistant Stated Clerk
- c) Recommend to presbytery a formula for the balance of Teaching and Ruling Elders at meetings of Presbytery in accordance with G-3.0301, G-3.0103 at the first meeting of the year.
- d) Provide management and oversight for resolutions, memorials, amendments and overtures
- e) Coordinate with Sessions and Clerks include with Congregational Health or Building Leaders Team in restructure so the job is for oversight
 - 1. Forward to each session blank forms of all reports required at the close of the year and manage the required annual reporting process from congregations.
 - 2. Coordinate/manage the annual review of session minutes from churches in the Presbytery.
 - 3. Provide annual training for clerks of sessions
- f) Maintain on-line records with General Assembly and Presbytery (TEs, candidates, inquirers, congregations, ordinations, receptions, dismissals, retirements, etc.) Provide oversight as actual work is done by volunteer Assistant Stated Clerk
 - g) Maintain Teaching Elder files in Presbytery office
 - h) Provide support and counsel to COM and CPM
 - i) Manage immigration issues for congregations, TEs and visiting dignitaries
 - j) Provide training, support and records management for PJC
 - k) Communicates disciplinary actions to the Presbytery as appropriate.

Mission Coordinator:

The duties of the Mission Coordinator shall be:

- a) To serve as pastor to CP's pastors and their families
- b) To provide advice, counsel, encouragement, coordination, and support to the Presbytery's leadership
- c) To prepare and distribute all appropriate agendas, information, reports, and recommendations necessary for each stated and called meeting of the Presbytery. CT, with restructure, will help with this in the future
- d) To assist CP's leadership persons and entities, particularly COM, in matters of problem solving, conflict resolution, and reconciliation, where relationships/issues call for new measures of healing and wholeness.
- e) To maintain open communication and teamwork relationships with staff colleagues
- f) To interpret and promote churchwide PC(USA) principles, polity, process, programs, and mission among all members, congregations, and entities of the Presbytery
- g) To facilitate the presbytery's vision and pursuit of the vision.
